What is Playgroup?

A playgroup is a group of mums, dads, grandparents and caregivers who meet together each week with their babies, toddlers and preschoolers for interaction and fun.

Parents and caregivers work together to provide their babies and young children with opportunities to learn through play.

Why go to Playgroup?

Changes happen very quickly as your baby grows and develops.

Research indicates that your baby's first three years are really important for brain development and future health and well-being. Play is central to your child's learning and development.

Play gives your baby lots of different ways and times to learn and develop.

Playgroup offers babies a wide range of stimulating early experiences to build confidence and skills, whilst also bringing parents and caregivers together with babies to enjoy regular play experiences. Importantly playgroup offers the opportunity for parents to meet, share ideas and information, and to make sense of the joys and frustrations of parenthood together.

Where do playgroups meet?

Playgroups are usually held once a week for a two hour session, and can be found in a variety of venues such as community and neighbourhood centres, council halls, schools and church halls.
