A group of mums, dads, grandparents and/or caregivers who meet together each week with their children for interaction and fun. They are run by parents and volunteers and each individual family is entitled to the benefits listed.	A playgroup operated by an organisation that charges fees directly to parents and arranges bookings and equipment. Families are not covered by Playgroup WA insurance. Staff may also assist the operation of playgroup sessions but are not directly funded to operate a supported playgroup.	A playgroup facilitated by a paid facilitator as part of a funded program.	Someone who attends playgroup without any children. Volunteers are able to take on committee roles or be part of playgroup sessions, however Playgroup Committee Members with children attending do not come under this category.
